Machu Picchu by Train: 2 Days/1 Night

Day Before Departure: Informative Briefing

A short meeting will take place the day before the tour. During this briefing, you'll receive all the details about your trip, including the exact pick-up time, your train tickets, and your Machu Picchu entrance ticket.

Day 1: Cusco - Train Station - Aguas Calientes

- A bus will pick you up from your accommodation. If it isn't near the main square, a meeting point will be arranged, and the bus will take you to the train station.
- Board the train to Aguas Calientes. Be sure to be on time.
- When you arrive at Aguas Calientes train station, look for someone from your hostel (the name will be shared i the briefing) holding a sign with your name.
- You can visit the hot springs nearby in the afternoon.
- Return to the hostel by the time the tour operator mentioned, where you'll meet your guide for information about your visit to Machu Picchu the next day.

<u>Day 2: Aguas Calientes - Machu Picchu - Train Station - Cusco</u>

- In the early morning, walk to the bus station and take a bus to Machu Picchu. The exact bus time will be given to you during the evening briefing.
- A guide will meet you at the entrance for a 2-hour tour of the ruins.
- After the tour, take the bus back to Aguas Calientes. Please ensure you arrive at the train station at least 30 minutes before the departure of your train.
- Be sure to get off at the right train station mentioned on your train ticket.
- Once getting off the train and exiting the train station, look for someone holding a sign with your name or calling your name. They will take you by bus to Cusco.
- The bus will drop you off near Plaza de Armas in the city center.

- Sunscreen and mosquito repellent
- Hat or cap
- Swimsuit (optional for the hot springs)
- Raincoat, just in raining season (October to March)
- Walking shoes
- Cash (soles) to buy souvenirs

- Advance Booking: It is recommended to book your tour at least 2 or 3 months
 before your arrival to secure the entrance tickets to Machu Picchu. If you want to
