

Sacred Valley

Meeting point: In front of Proyecto Peru Centre (Arcopata 466) at **6:50 TO 7:00 AM.**

Program:

This one-day tour is a quick way to see the highlights of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. In the morning, you will leave Cusco and you will first visit the **complex of Pisac** representing one of the most important archaeological sites of this region, located about 30 km NW of Cusco.

Later, we will continue to a colonial town named Pisac, established as a consequence of the well-known "Indian Reductions" by which scattered indigenous people were forced to move to small towns established by Spaniards. We will visit its famous traditional handicraft market.

Afterwards, we will be taken by bus to **Urubamba**, the capital of the valley, to enjoy lunch. Later we will go to the town of **Ollantaytambo** to visit other famous ruins. Ollantaytambo was an administrative, social, religious and agricultural center during the Inca times. The ruins and the town are a must-see amongst the many other interesting sites of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Finally, we will visit the town of **Chincho** with its Inca site as well as a beautiful Colonial church and streets. We will come back to Cusco between **6:30 – 7:00 PM.**
