Brief Description

Maras: a town near the city of Cusco in the Sacred Valley of southeastern Peru. It's known for the Maras Salt Mines, thousands of individual salt pools on a hillside, dating back to Incan times.

Moray: an archaeological site just west of the village of Maras. The site contains unusual Inca ruins, mostly consisting of several terraced circular depressions. It is possible that this large temperature differences in the terracing was used by the Inca to study the effects of different climatic conditions on crops.
