Brief Description

This Tour is a quick way to see the highlights of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. In the morning, you will leave Cusco and first visit one of the most important archaeological sites in the region-**Las Ruinas de Pisac**.

Later on, we will visit the colonial town, **Pisac**, located just below the architectural site. It was established as a result of the well-known "Indian Reductions" by which scattered indigenous people were forced to move in to small towns established by Spaniards. Presently Pisac, we will visit its famous traditional handicraft market.

Afterwards, we will be taken by our bus to **Urubamba**, the capital of the valley, to enjoy lunch there.

Later, we will go to the town of **Ollantaytambo** to visit other famous ruins. Ollantaytambo was an administrative, social, religious and agricultural centre during the Inca times. The ruins and the town is a must-see amongst the many other interesting sites of the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

Finally, we will visit the town of **Chinchero** with its Inca site as well as beautiful colonial church and streets.
