SALKANTAY TO MACHUPICCHU 5 D / 4 By CAR

DAY 1: CUSCO - SORAYPAMPA

We start with the pick up from 4:30 am to 5:00 AM. We leave Cusco, going through the towns of Izcuchaca and Limatambo arriving at Mollepata where we will be approximately at 7:30 AM where we can have breakfast about 40 min. Approx. After breakfast we will continue traveling in the same transport until we reach Challacancha which will be the beginning of the walk where we will also meet our muleteers and horses that will transport our camping equipment and food. Then we will continue our journey to Soraypampa instead of our first campsite and where we will have lunch, then visit the HUMANTAY lagoon in a walk of 1:30 min approx. After the visit, return to our camp and have our afternoon tea and dinner.

CUSCO-MOLLEPATA: 90 KM 3:30 MIN BY BUS MOLLEPATA-SORAYPAMPA 19 KM 7-8 HOURS WALKING

DAY 2: SORAYMAPA - CHAULLAY

At 7:00 am we will have breakfast to continue with our walk, we will have an ascent of approximately 3 hours until we reach the highest point of our entire Paso Salkantay pass, 4600 m.s. From this point we will descend to the place called Wayrac where we will have lunch, then we will resume the walk, entering the landscape of the jungle, in this section we will appreciate formations of the rivers that later become tributaries of the Urubamba River, variety of typical plants from the place, we arrive to chaullay, where we will spend the night.

SORAYPAMPA-CHAULLAY 21 KM 9-10 HOURS WALKING

DAY 3: CHAULLAY - PLAYA-SANTA TERESA

It is a spectacular day to descend through cloud forests, where the vegetation develops capriciously. It is the place to recognize some species such as Orchids, Bromeliads, Bomareas and etc. We visited some families in Wiñaypoco (2650m) and La Playa (2100m) we will have our succulent lunch, then we will take a transport that will take us to the town of sata teresa place of our camp. Where you will have the option of visiting the thermal baths of Cocal Mayo (the cost of transportation to the thermal baths in our package is not included)Hiking time 6 hours, warm during our trip. Includes breakfast, lunch and dinner.

CHAULLAY-PLAYA 13 KM 5 HOURS WALKING

PLAYA-SANTA TERESA 20 KM 1:45 MIN BY BUS

DAY 4: DAY SANTA TERESA - MACHUPICCHU PUEBLO (Hike)

in the morning after breakfast, we take a flat walk through the valley floor from santa teresa to hydroelectric anatpproximate 3:00 hrs, appreciating the landscape bordered by mountains and nature, reaching a hydroelectric, we have a comfortable lunch to continue with our walk to the town of aguas calientes an approximate 3hrs, along the banks of the Urubamba river as well as following the railroad track of the railroad until we reach hot springs, in this trek we can appreciate vegetation of the area as well as fauna, arriving to the town of aguas calientes, there we will have dinner and we will spend our last night.

DAY 5: MACHUPICCHU CUSCO

In the early morning around 4.30 in the morning we will ascend to the majestic Inka citadel of Machupicchu where we will have a guided tour of approximately 2hrs, the rest of the day we will have free to take pictures or visit the famous mountain of Huayna Picchu or mountain Machupicchu (optional reservations must be made in advance), Inti Punku, in the afternoon we return to the town of aguas calientes considering the return time of our bus and then take a tourist bus to the Imperial city of Cusco
