

Machu Picchu 2 Days/1 Night

Day 1: Cusco – Aguas Calientes

From your place where you're staying, a bus will bring you to Ollantaytambo train station. There, you'll catch a train heading to Aguas Calientes. It's important to be punctual. Upon arriving at Aguas Calientes train station, someone from the hostel will meet you. They'll either hold a sign with your name or call out your name. If you'd like, you can spend the afternoon visiting the nearby hot springs, so bring your swimsuit. These hot springs are within walking distance from the hostel. Make sure to be back at the hostel on time in the evening, around 7:00-8:00 PM, for a meeting. Your tour guide will come to the hostel to give you all the details you need for visiting Machu Picchu the next day.

Day 2: Aguas Calientes – Machu Picchu – Cusco

Early in the morning, you'll walk to the nearby bus station from the hostel and take a bus to Machu Picchu to explore the ancient ruins. The exact bus departure time will be shared the night before during the briefing. You'll have a tour guide with you for about an hour. In the afternoon, make sure you arrive at the train station in Aguas Calientes at least thirty minutes before your train to Ollantaytambo departs. Your train's departure time will be printed on your ticket. Once you arrive at Ollantaytambo, exit the train station and look for a person holding a sign with your name. They will take you to a bus heading to Cusco. Since there are many buses and tourists, you might wait up to 10 minutes to be picked up. If you wait longer, you can call Jurgen. The bus will drop you off in the city center, near Plaza de Armas.
